  - To include all contributions received and expenditures made through twenty-eight (28) days prior to the general election, excluding those previously reported.
- GEN ELECTION REPORT: Required by all candidates who participated in the General Election. Due by 5:00 PM on November 14, 2023, which is no later than seven (7) days <u>before</u> the date of the general election.

To include all contributions received and expenditures made during the entire campaign, excluding those previously reported.

FINAL: Required by all candidates who participated in the General Election. Due by 5:00 p.m. on December 21, 2023, which is no later than thirty (30) days <u>after</u> the date of the general election.

To include all contributions received and expenditures made during the entire campaign excluding those previously reported.

# PROVISIONS OF TAYLORSVILLE CITY CODE AND THE UTAH CODE ANNOTATED

## **TAYLORSVILLE CITY CODE 2.36.030**

A. No person shall make contributions during any election cycle, as set forth in this chapter, to any candidate, his/her personal campaign committee, or any political committee with respect to any election for city office, that, in the aggregate, exceeds the following amounts:

Mayor - \$7,500

Councilmember - \$1,500

- B. The acceptance of anonymous contributions is prohibited. Any anonymous contribution received by a candidate or a personal campaign committee or political committee shall be transmitted to the city treasurer for deposit in the general fund of the city. Each contributor shall disclose to the personal campaign committee or political committee the name and address of such contributor.
- C. The limitation imposed above shall not apply to contributions by a candidate of the candidate's own resources to the candidate's own campaign. (Ord. 13-19, 8-7-2013)

# **TAYLORSVILLE CITY CODE 2.36.040**

- A. All candidates for municipal office shall comply with campaign finance disclosure requuirements as prescribed in Utah Code Annotated 10-3-208 or its successors.
- B. In addition to the requirements set forth in subsection A of this section, each elected official and/or candidate for municipal office shall file with the city recorder a campaign finance statement containing the information required in this section on March 1 of each year. (Ord. 16-20, 12-14-2016)

## **UTAH CODE ANNOTATED 10-3-208(3)**

Each candidate: (a) shall deposit a contribution in a **separate campaign account** in a financial institution; and (b) may not deposit or mingle any campaign contributions received into a personal or business account.

### ATTACHMENT A - CONTRIBUTIONS

Contribution means any of the following when done for political purposes:

- A. A gift, subscription, donation, loan, advance, transfer of funds, or deposit of money or anything of value given to a Candidate;
- B. an express, legally enforceable contract, promise, or agreement to make a gift, subscription, donation, unpaid or partially unpaid loan, advance, or deposit of money or anything of value to the candidate;
- C. any transfer of funds from another reporting entity to the candidate;
- D. compensation paid by any person or reporting entity other than the candidate for personal services provided without charge to the candidate;
- E. a loan made by a candidate deposited to the candidate's own campaign; and
- F. an in-kind contribution

### Contribution does <u>not</u> include:

- A. services provided by an individual volunteering a portion or all of the individual's time on behalf of the candidate if the services are provided without compensation by the candidate or another person;
- B. money lent to the candidate by a financial institution in the ordinary course of business;
- C. goods or services provided for the benefit of a candidate at less than fair market value that are not authorized by or coordinated with the candidate. For purposes of this paragraph, "coordinated with" means the goods or services were provided: with the candidate's prior knowledge, if the candidate does not object; by agreement with the candidate; or using official logos, slogans, and similar elements belonging to a candidate.

## ATTACHMENT B - EXPENDITURES OR OBLIGATIONS

### Expenditure means:

Any of the following when done for Political Purposes:

- A. Any disbursement from contributions, receipts, or from an account established by a campaign.
- B. A purchase, payment, donation, distribution, Loan, transfer of funds, advance, or gift of money or anything of value made by a Candidate or Reporting Entity to a Person:
- C. An express, legally enforceable contract, promise, or agreement entered into by a Candidate or other Reporting Entity that obligates him/it to make a purchase, payment, donation, distribution, loan, advance, deposit, gift of money, transfer of funds, or anything of value to a Person;
- D. Payment by a Candidate or other Reporting Entity for goods or personal services;
- E. A transfer of funds by a Reporting Entity to another Reporting Entity.
- F. A Candidate or Reporting Entity providing goods or services to or for the benefit of a Candidate or Issue at less than fair market value.
- G. The use or disbursement of Personal Funds in furtherance of a Candidate's own campaign.

### Expenditure does not include:

- A. Providing non-professional volunteer services for which compensation is not customarily provided, such as door-to-door or telephonic canvassing, when compensation is in fact not provided; or
- B. Money lent to a Candidate by a financial institution in the ordinary course of business.
