Financial Disclosures

- **Campaign Finance Statements:**

- If the Candidate receives or spends \$500 or less:
 - Report the total aggregate amount of all contributions and expenditures
- If a candidate receives or spends \$500 or more:
 - Report all itemized:
 - Contributions, including amount and donor
 - Expenditures, including amount and recipient
 - Candidates who receive or spend \$500 or more can no longer aggregate certain contributions.

- **Personal Use Expenditure Prohibited**

- Candidates may not make a personal use expenditure with campaign money. Personal use includes
 - Mortgage
 - Car payment
 - Vacation
 - Meal expenses
 - Travel expenses
 - Clothing (except campaign t-shirts)

- **Anonymous Donations**

- If a candidate receives an anonymous cash donation that is over \$50, the candidate must give the money to
 - State or political subdivision to deposit the money into the general fund
 - 501(c)(3) organization

September 18, 2023, by 5 pm. Write-in Candidate deadline

20A-9-601. Qualifying as a write-in candidate.

(1) (a) Except as provided in Subsection (1)(b), an individual who wishes to become a valid write-in candidate shall file a declaration of candidacy in person or through a designated agent for a candidate for president or vice president of the United States, with the appropriate filing officer **before 5 p.m.** no later than 65 days before the regular general election or a municipal general election in which the individual intends to be a write-in candidate.

September 18, 2023, by 5 p.m. is the Deadline to withdraw from the Election.

This will need a written statement of your official withdrawal.

September 22, 2023, Candidate Profile Due for vote.utah.gov

Deadline for candidates to submit an optional 200-word profile to the Lt. Governor's Office for the Primary Election. See Page 12 of this packet for information on submitting your profile. [UCA § 20A-7-801(4)]

October 24, 2023, by 5 p.m. Campaign Financial Disclosure

This is the last day for candidates to file a signed campaign financial disclosure with the City Recorder, 28 days prior to the General Election. [UCA § 10-3-208(4)(b)(i)]

November 14, 2023, by 5 pm, Campaign Financial Disclosure

This is the last day for candidates to file a signed campaign financial disclosure with the City Recorder, 7 days prior to the General Election. [UCA § 10-3-208(4)(b)(ii)]

November 21, 2023, General Municipal Election

Polls open at 7:00 AM and close at 8:00 PM. [UCA § 20A-1-202]

An individual who is not registered to vote may register to vote and vote on election day by casting a provisional ballot. [UCA § 20A-3a-601]

December 6, 2023, Last Day to Canvass General Election Returns

Last day the Board of Canvassers may canvass the General Election returns. The Board of Canvassers meets to canvass the returns no sooner than seven days after the election and no later than fourteen days after the election. [UCA § 20A-4-301]

December 21, 2023, by 5 pm, Campaign Financial Disclosure

This is the last day for candidates to file a signed campaign financial disclosure with the City Recorder, 7 days prior to the General Election. [UCA § 10-3-208(4)(b)(ii)]

How to SUBMIT YOUR CANDIDATE PROFILE

The Lieutenant Governor's Office provides candidates with the opportunity to submit a candidate profile for the website VOTE.UTAH.GOV. Your profile includes biographical information, a picture, and a short statement, and it will be available for voters to see.

HOW DO I SUBMIT MY PROFILE?

1. Visit the website VOTE.UTAH.GOV. Select the button "Resources for Candidates, Political Groups & Parties" at the bottom of the page.
 2. After being directed to a new page, select the option "Submit candidate profile."
 3. You will be directed to the UtahID portal. If you do not have a UtahID account, you must create one to proceed. If you already have a UtahID account, simply log into your account.
 4. After creating your UtahID account, you will be prompted for a PIN number. To obtain a PIN number, select your name in the dropdown menu, then check your email.
 5. After selecting your name in the dropdown menu, you will receive an email with your PIN number. Your PIN number will be sent to the email address that you provided on your declaration of candidacy. It will not be sent to the email address of your UtahID account.
 6. After receiving your PIN number, enter it into the website and click "Submit."
 7. After entering your PIN number, the website will prompt you to enter your candidate profile. After you are completed, click "Submit for Approval." You have the ability to save and edit your profile before the deadline.

WHEN DO I SUBMIT MY PROFILE?

You must submit your profile before the following deadlines:

General Election Profiles: *Friday, September 22, 2023, at 5:00 p.m. (Mountain Time)*

Please note that these deadlines are established by law. As a result, late submissions and edits cannot be accepted.
