

A. Disclosure Duty: Each candidate for elected municipal office shall report financial contributions in full compliance with state law, including those in Utah Code section 10-3-208 and title 20A, chapter 11, or successor provisions; provided that for city elective offices, such disclosure of campaign contributions shall take place at the same times and in the same detail in connection with both city primary elections and city general elections.

B. Report Filing: The filings required by this section shall be made with the city clerk-recorder. The statements so filed shall be public records. (2001 Code § 2-4-207; amd. 2009 Code; Ord. 14-05, 02-12-2014)

&&1-7A-8: POLITICAL ACTION COMMITTEES AND POLITICAL ISSUE COMMITTEES:

A. Disclosure Duty: Each political action committee and political issue committee providing financial or in-kind support to a candidate for elected municipal office or in connection with an issue shall report concerning itself and with respect to financial and other contributions as provided in Utah Code Title 20A, Chapter 11, or successor provisions; provided that such disclosure shall take place at the same times and in the same detail in connection with both city primary elections and city general elections.

B. Report Filing: The filings required by this section shall be made with the city clerk-recorder. The statements so filed shall be public records. (Ord. 14-05, 02-12-2014)

****PLEASE TAKE NOTE OF THE CITY'S NEW REQUIREMENT REGARDING POLITICAL ACTION**

Utah Code Annotated 10-3-208, in its entirety; and West Jordan Municipal Code, 1-7A-7 UCA 10-3-208:

"(5) Notwithstanding any provision of Title 63, Chapter 2, Government Records Access and Management Act, the municipal clerk or recorder shall:

- (a) make each campaign finance statement filed by a candidate available for public inspection by:
 - (i) (A) posting an electronic copy or the contents of the statement on the municipality's website no later than seven business days after the statement is filed; and
 - (B) verifying that the address of the municipality's website has been provided to the lieutenant governor in order to meet the requirements of Subsection 20A-11-103(5); or
 - (ii) submitting a copy of the statement to the lieutenant governor for posting on the website established by the lieutenant governor under Section 20A-11-103 no later than two business days after the statement is filed.

(6)(a) If a candidate fails to file a campaign finance statement before the municipal general election by the deadline specified in Subsection (2)(a)(i)(A), the municipal clerk or recorder shall inform the appropriate election official who:

- (i) shall:
 - (A) if practicable, remove the candidate's name from the ballot by blacking out the candidate's name before the ballots are delivered to voters.
 - (B) if removing the candidate's name from the ballot is not practicable, inform the voters by any practicable method that the candidate has been disqualified and that votes cast for the candidate will not be counted; and
- (ii) may not count any votes for that candidate.
